4.2 Proposal that sail numbers become available for reissue

Approved with the following rules

Ownership of a sail number

- AWA controls the issue of Sail Numbers for all windsurfing in Australia.
 - A current list of registered numbers will the displayed on the "Australian Windsurfing" web site
 - o Members of AWA affiliated bodies have the right to a number at no cost

- Numbers will not be issued to non-members
- o Non-members may lose the ownership of a number
- "KA" numbers will not be issued
- Life ownership of a number is revoked.
 Those wishing to keep a number will need to be financial with their state association (see Number Expiration below).

Number Expiration

- If a number registrant fails to appear on the "AWA member list" for 2 consecutive financial years (July-June), the number may be made available to someone else.
- A person is added to the list when their state association provides information about financial members to AWA, during a financial year, and pays the appropriate fees.
- A current list of registered members will the displayed on the "Australian Windsurfing" web site

Applicants must provide the following information

- First Name mandatory
- Last Name mandatory
- Address optional
- State & Postcode mandatory
- A valid email address mandatory

Other

- These rules will come into effect on July 1 2006.
- 2005/06 non-members may lose their right to a allocated number if they are still un-financial at the end of the 2006/07 year.
- Special allowances may be made for International Competitors.

The database custodian is still John Rohde, with number applications being received thru the state reps.

RSX fee may be reduced next year. This amount is more than would be paid by the sailors if they had to make the payment instead at events. Comment that RSX is very elite and won't help grow the sport.

AWA to invoice State Associations to recover IWA fees from events. The fee has been previously stated as:-

- o A \$10 per head levy should be built into National events through the entry fee
- There should be a \$10 per head levy for any National Championship affiliated with an IWA Class
